Our Staff

The most important aspect of any camp is the staff. At Camp Herrlich, we pride ourselves on our long-standing tradition of hiring caring, competent, and experienced individuals. Our staff is carefully selected from all over the world and from our local community based on skills, maturity, values, and ability to provide a positive experience for the children we care for. All staff participate in a mandatory orientation at Camp Herrlich, which provides training in areas ranging from emergency procedures to positive reinforcement for children.

Health and Safety

Care and safety of our campers are of utmost importance to us. Full-time medical staff and a fully equipped first aid station are located at the camp. All campers are required to have a SIGNED Medical Information Form on file in the Camp Herrlich Health Center. As required by the Putnam County Department of Health, we must also have a copy of your child's immunization record, signed or stamped by his/her physician.

Please do not send an ill child to camp. Our medical personnel is available to attend to accidental injuries and unsuspected illnesses. Sending a sick child will only prolong the healing process and may put other campers at risk.

Accommodations

Campers are housed in rustic, comfortable, clean cabins. There are two separate cabin villages, one for boys and one for girls. Both villages have wash houses with hot/cold running water, showers, and flush facilities. Each village also has a fire circle for the enjoyment of campfire gatherings.

Meals

Our dining hall serves hearty, well-balanced meals in a family style atmosphere. A fruit assortment is provided at breakfast and snacktime and a salad bar with a huge assortment of fresh vegetables and fruits accompanies each lunch and dinner. Cold cereal is always an alternative to the hot breakfast. We make every effort to tend to special dietary needs.

Permits and Licenses

Camp Herrlich is operated by Mount Tremper Outdoor Ministries, Inc. (MTOM). MTOM and Camp Herrlich have a permit to operate by the New York State Department of Health. The camp is inspected twice annually. Copies of the inspection reports are available upon request at NYS (Putnam County) Department of Health, 4 Geneva Road, Brewster NY 10509. Background information on choosing a summer camp and the health and safety requirements for summer camps is available from Camp Herrlich. This information will be made available upon registration to every family and can be accessed prior to registration by request. MTOM and Camp Herrlich are accredited by the American Camp Association.

Directions to Camp

Driving: Interstate 684 North toward Brewster to Interstate 84 West toward Newburgh. Take Exit 18 (Lake Carmel) and turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp onto Route 311. Turn right at the first street (Fair Street) and then immediately turn left onto Deacon Smith Hill Road. Proceed down the hill to the stop sign. The entrance to the camp is on your right.

Train: Metro North Harlem Line from Grand Central Station to Southeast Station. Cabs are available from Southeast to camp, about a 10-minute ride.

The \$200 deposit is refundable up until June 1, 2015, less a \$50 administrative fee per camper. If you find it necessary to cancel after June 1st, your \$200 deposit will NOT be refunded. Fees paid in excess of \$200 will be refunded at our earliest convenience. Deposits may be transferred to another session or to a sibling IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE. Deposits and fees are NOT transferable under any other circumstances.

MTOM and Camp Herrlich reserve the right to change or cancel any camp/program/trip/activity due to circumstances beyond our control.

Camp Store

Each camper gets an afternoon snack from the Camp Store on a daily basis as part of their programming. The Camp Store also sells souvenirs like sunglasses, t-shirts, beanie babies, and some candy items. When you register, you will receive a list of Camp Store items and their prices. You are welcome to send your child with extra money to make purchases from the Camp Store so they can bring their Camp Herrlich experience home with them. The Camp Store will be open periodically throughout their stay with us.

TRANSPORTATION—We provide transportation for all campers who need it from central locations throughout the New York Metropolitan area. The following stops are available:

- Bronx:** Corner of East Tremont and Third Avenue
- Brooklyn:** Corner of Hanson Place and Flatbush Avenue (outside the Atlantic Terminal LIRR station)
- Manhattan:** The Church of the Village (at 13th and 7th Avenue)
- Queens:** Corner of Queens Blvd and Junction Blvd (outside the TD Bank)

If you would like bus service, please check the appropriate box on the registration form. Transportation fees have been included in the cost of registration for your convenience. Upon receipt, we will send you a confirmation package, including a bus time schedule.

Campers NOT using our bus transportation service must be dropped off at camp between 2:00 and 4:00 PM on the first day of the session (Sunday) and must be picked up by 12:00 noon on Friday, the last day of the session.

Resident Camp CIT Program—If you will be 16 years old by July 5, 2015 and want to be a counselor at Camp Herrlich, you can apply for our Counselor in Training program. It will take place from July 5 to July 31 (campers will arrive on July 5, leave on July 17, and return on July 19) and costs \$500.00. Please call the camp office for an application or download one from our website.
