Monthly Tuition Schedule

We understand that busy working parents need the **advantage** of flexibility. We've designed our program so that you can choose the number of mornings per week to enroll your child and pay for **only** the days that you've enrolled!

First month's tuition must be paid prior to the program start date. Thereafter, billing will be processed on a monthly basis, a month in advance. A \$100 deposit or first month's tuition (whichever is less) is required with each registration prior to the beginning of school. If you are registering after school has begun, the first month's tuition is due upon registration.
